FAQ

1. What level of piano students are accepted?

These lessons are for intermediate to advanced/professional level.

Given the online teaching and use of Skype, Mr Antonov is unable to accept beginners.

2. Are there any restrictions on students locations?

The Skype lessons are open to students from any country.

In the United States, the lessons are open to all states.

The only restriction applies to students residing within 30 miles of Grapevine, Texas area. If you are a student from that area, please contact The Master's Touch School of Music at 817-488-6903 and request to study with Avguste Antonov.

3. How is a typical lesson going?

-the student will begin by playing/showing the work he has done

-then, Mr. Antonov will work with the student on improving the piece(pieces)

4. Can a student send a recording of the piece(pieces) to be worked on before the lesson?

Yes, a student is welcome to do so. The recording needs to be sent in either Windows Media or MP3 format.

Alternatively, the student is welcome to send a video recording.
